A million years ago there were a lot more *species of animals than now. Of course, some species disappear *naturally, but today they are disappearing faster than before.

Animals are *in danger from natural accidents; some animals die because of small changes in the weather. But animals are also in danger from our *behavior. We cannot (①) from accidents or changing weather, but we can think about our behavior and change that.

We put new buildings on empty land and do not think about animals. We make new roads; we move rivers; we take away trees.

Some visitors to new places take pictures of animals, but other visitors hunt and kill them. They do not kill the animals for food, but (②).

In many countries people can also make a lot of money from animals. Elephants die because people want *ivory. *Rhinoceros die because people want to buy their *horns. Many bigger animals are in danger because their coats are beautiful and some people would like to have them to put in their house, or to wear.

*Pollution of our land, seas, rivers and skies is getting worse. We are making our world a much *dirtier place, so many animals cannot live in it. Pollution is bad for all of us. It is killing animals. Later it is going to (③).

The number of people in the world is getting bigger all the time. More people in bigger cities take more land and make more pollution. So, we are taking away the natural homes of animals very fast. Where can they go? In the end, we can't find the answer anywhere, so the animals will die.

Team members may not know ①(they / to / which / listen / should / leader). Different leaders may make different decisions at the same time. And, this can cause big problems.

So, if your team already has a leader, you should follow him or her. (②). If you don't agree with the leader, don't *argue with him or her. You should wait and talk to the leader *face-to-face. Always tell your leader important information. But, support the leader's decisions, too. You need to ③do this even if you have a different idea. If the leader gives you a job to do, you should do your best to help the team and your leader by doing that job well.

If you are not the leader, you still need to think for yourself. If you have a problem, you should first try to solve it yourself. Or, ask for another team member's (4). If the problem is too big or important, you should tell your leader. (5), the team can think about answers to the problem together.

4 次の英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

There is a story about trolls in *Sweden. Trolls are big, *ugly *monsters. They are small and scary, and make trouble around the house. This story comes from a woman in Sweden called Sonja. It is a true story, she says, and it really happened to her.

When I was a little girl, many years ago, I lived with my mother and father and grandfather in my grandfather's house. It was an old house with a big garden. There were a lot of fruit trees in it. My mother and my father both worked all day, so my grandfather took care of me. I loved my grandfather and I followed him everywhere. When he was working, I liked to watch, and I always tried to help.

One sunny morning after breakfast my grandfather went out into the garden and I went with him. He looked at one of the old apple trees, then went back into the house. I followed him. He began to look for his *tools. He found a *metal *saw, for cutting wood. But now it was old and broken.

'Are you going to cut some wood, Grandpa?' I asked.

'No, little Sonja,' Grandpa said. 'This old saw is broken now. But it can still do a job, and you can help. I'll need a *hammer and some *nails too. Please carry the nails for me. I'll carry the hammer because it's heavy.'

Grandpa carried the broken saw and the hammer into the garden. I followed him with the nails. I said to myself, ①'I'm helping Grandpa!'

In the garden, Grandpa went to one of the old apple trees and put the broken saw into the tree. First he made a little cut in the tree, and then pushed the saw hard into the cut. Then he took three nails from me, and hammered them into the tree, around the old saw. It was a very old tree, and I saw that there were lots of old nails in it.

Grandpa finished. 'There,' he said. 'That's good. The saw won't fall out of the tree now.'

'Grandpa,' I asked. 'Why did you ②<u>do that</u>?'

'Because of trolls,' Grandpa said.

I knew that a troll was a kind of monster. People said they were ugly and scary and dangerous, and that they did bad things. But I did not know what they did.

'Trolls don't like metals,' said Grandpa. 'If you put something metal in a tree, like that old saw, then the trolls will stay away. They will not come into your garden or into your house while the metal is there.'

He touched the tree, with the old nails in it.

'My father put metal in these trees,' he said, 'and my grandfather did it before him, and his father before that. And I do the same. I'm teaching you, little Sonja, so you'll know. And that's why we put that old saw in this tree.'

'What will happen if you don't put something metal in a tree?' I asked.
